



## Preventing Terrorism, Pelindo Establishes Synergy with BNPT

Jakarta, 11 April 2023 - PT Pelabuhan Indonesia (Persero) / Pelindo and the National Agency for Combating Terrorism / BNPT RI signed a Cooperation Agreement on the Synergy of Prevention of Criminal Acts of Terrorism. Taking place at the Ministry of SOEs, this agreement was signed by Bangbang Surono, Ak., M.M., CA., Main Secretary (Sestama) of BNPT RI and Arif Suhartono, Main Director of Pelindo, and witnessed by Komjen. This collaboration is a follow-up to the memorandum of understanding between BNPT and KBUMN in October 2019 concerning the Synergy of Prevention of Terrorism in the Ministry of State-Owned Enterprises and State-Owned Enterprises.
