**Jakarta, 10 June 2023** - PT Pelindo Solusi Logistik or SPSL, which is a subholding of PT Pelabuhan Indonesia (Persero) BUMN BUMN, held a coastal clean up (CCU) on the East Coast of Ancol, Jakarta, Saturday (10/6).

As much as 2.2 tons of waste, both organic and inorganic, were collected in the beach clean-up activities. Of the waste collected, around 94 percent is plastic waste. This is one of the facts that public awareness of environmental cleanliness is still relatively low. The beach clean-up activity (CCU) with the theme "Solutions to Plastic Pollution (Solutions to Plastic Pollution) and carrying out the #beatplasticpollution campaign, is
